### LRRL REPORT FROM THE CHAIR 19TH OCTOBER 2015

Firstly a big Thank You to the people without whom the League would not enjoy the success it does Peter Osborne, Carol Fossard, Mike Stiff, John Skevington for organising the TTRO's etc and his advice to race organisers also thanks to Dave Lodwick for organising the Presentation Evening and providing me with advice and guidance in my role as Chair during the last 12 months and thanks to the Clubs and you the delegates for supporting this great Road Running League the envy of many counties I feel !

Also all of the clubs who have arranged League races in 2015 deserve a lot of praise as we have had record levels of participation; an early indicator of this were the 667 runners who lined up at Barrow in January this of course brings its own problems with parking and accommodating the runners at the traditional venues we have used for many years and I know from experience this poses headaches for organising teams. But to my knowledge, all the races were Incident Free, (other than at Hungarton when the temperatures reached levels that could not have been anticipated but I am pleased to report the prompt reaction of both Paramedics and the Wreake volunteers helped avoid any major dramas or serious casualties) At other events i am sure there were a few minor dramas which all host clubs dealt with very well without any of us even being aware which is a testimony to all of those volunteers within the clubs who promote well organised professional events for the love of the sport

During 2015 we welcomed 2 new clubs to the League, Poplar Running Club from Loughborough and Anstey Amblers & Runners and it was pleasing to both see and hear them at the League Presentation Evening at Grace Rd

John Skevington's Club Share Initiative has been well supported by The League Clubs and the wider nonaligned running community With a particularly impressive turnout at Bradgate Park The increase in interest in running and racing (there were 1090 people who ran at least one race in the LRRL) will pose problems in 2016 not least with the allocation of chips. An insistence on car share is becoming almost the norm so I would ask all club delegates to take this message back to their clubs and impress upon their members the importance of clubbing together for lifts to ease the pressure on host clubs I am sure 2016 will be an even better year than 2015 with more clubs and different distances and courses being put forward for inclusion in the LRRL
