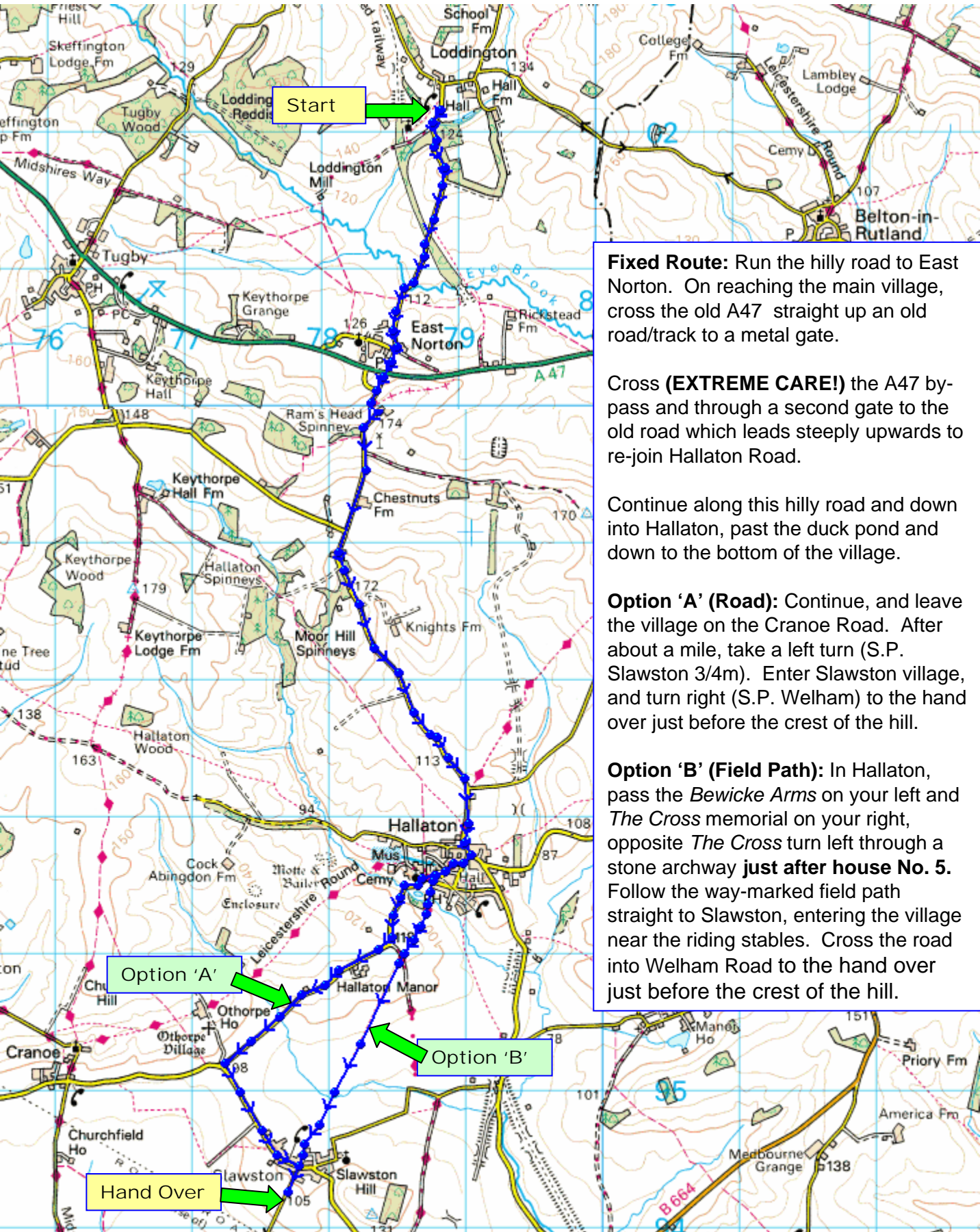


LEG E – LODDINGTON TO SLAWSTON

A **FIXED ROUTE** to Hallaton (2 alternative finishes) of approx 9.6km (6 miles).



Start

Fixed Route: Run the hilly road to East Norton. On reaching the main village, cross the old A47 straight up an old road/track to a metal gate.

Cross (**EXTREME CARE!**) the A47 bypass and through a second gate to the old road which leads steeply upwards to re-join Hallaton Road.

Continue along this hilly road and down into Hallaton, past the duck pond and down to the bottom of the village.

Option 'A' (Road): Continue, and leave the village on the Craneo Road. After about a mile, take a left turn (S.P. Slawston 3/4m). Enter Slawston village, and turn right (S.P. Welham) to the hand over just before the crest of the hill.

Option 'B' (Field Path): In Hallaton, pass the *Bewicke Arms* on your left and *The Cross* memorial on your right, opposite *The Cross* turn left through a stone archway **just after house No. 5**. Follow the way-marked field path straight to Slawston, entering the village near the riding stables. Cross the road into Welham Road to the hand over just before the crest of the hill.
